


Appeal to the Minister for Social Housing, The Hon. Brad Hazzard



COWPER STREET GLEBE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Dear Minister,

I/we, the undersigned, protest that the area above in yellow will be sold to the private sector when there is such a shortage of housing. We demand that the Government use the whole property at Cowper Street, Glebe for social and affordable housing to help meet this need.

The Government promised us 'mix' but is creating a barrier to good neighbourly relations by making Stirling Street a border between the social and the private homes.

We suggest that the land coloured yellow be used for essential worker accommodation (affordable housing), student accommodation and a project for the homeless like Common Ground.

In our view it is scandalous in this climate of housing crisis that the Government is selling off Government land which could be used for the people. Public housing projects on public land could well be funded from the billions of dollars that the State Government is receiving from stamp duty.
